# WHAT I CAN OFFER YOU...

I now offer a range of services to support you in your setting. These services are appropriate regardless of your role or setting type. If you're not sure if we'd be a good match then drop me an email and we can discuss your needs.

## TRAINING

I now offer training in-person again. I can come and deliver training on a range of topics bespoke to your setting. However I do have some sessions already written, these are below. All of my courses can be delivered in bitesize (1.5/2 hours) or we can use a half/full day to go much deeper.

## LOOSE PARTS

Loose parts is slowly becoming a staple in Early Years settings up and down the country. However many settings fail to understand the true power of Loose Parts play. Children can use open-ended resources to demonstrate creative and critical thinking as well as play out significant experiences.

My training takes us back to the start so that we can fully understand the impact Loose Parts can have. We then explore how to develop your whole provision so that we can bring this open-ended approach to your entire setting.

# FABULOUS PHASE 1 PHONICS

Too many practitioners rush children towards phase 2 phonics and don't spend the time they need on developing the foundations in Phase 1. Children need to have a solid understanding about recognising and making sounds, keeping a beat, understanding speech sounds as well as learning how to talk about the sounds they hear. This course explores each aspect of phase 1 through hands on activities. I mix in plenty of theory so that practitioners understand their 'why.'

# OPEN-ENDED STORYTELLING

Human beings are naturally disposed to tell stories. However in our settings stories often find themselves trapped in a carpet session or a story corner. Storytelling can support a child's wider creativity, their language development, their confidence as well as their social skills. Much of this comes from an experienced practitioner having the confidence to stop and listen to the wonderful stories our children have to tell.

# PURPOSEFUL PROVISION

Children deserve Provision that doesn't just look good, it is Purposeful! Many settings are now moving towards aesthetically pleasing environments but children aren't accessing the resources and developing their learning. Why? This course delves into the 'why' of provision. Practitioners think carefully about their uniqueness and explore how to develop provision that matches this perfectly.

# PASSIONATE PRACTITIONERS

This course is all about the role of the adult. Arguably the most important resource in your setting, you are best placed to support your learners to get to where they need to. Through this course we explore the role of language, how to tune into the needs and interests of the children (expertly!) and how to create a culture where children can excel.

## IN-THE-MOMENT COACHING

Coaching is all about working alongside practitioners to recognise the strengths and weaknesses in their practice. My coaching is 'in-the-moment' where I work alongside practitioners to change their practice in real time. I provide a complete report afterwards with next steps for each practitioner.

## CONSULTANCY

Coaching is all about guiding staff towards excellent practice but it requires some independent study. Consultancy on the other hand is about giving direct advice with actionable points. 
## DROP IN ZOOM SUPPORT
