


WHERE I DELIVER TRAINING



I am happy to come and deliver training to any setting located in the green zones above. If your school or setting is in an amber area please contact me. I may still be able to come and deliver but the price may be higher (due to hotel stays/ferry crossings etc.)

CHOOSING YOUR DELIVERY MODEL:

I now offer three delivery models for settings to choose from.

IN-PERSON SINGLE SCHOOL/SETTING

You can book me to come and deliver to just your team for a flat fee. This way I can make adaptations to suit your ethos and style. Check out each course to see the maximum number of attendees.

IN-PERSON HOSTING

By far my most popular delivery method. Settings provide a large space, chairs, tea and coffee and I provide them with 1/4 of the tickets for free. The remaining tickets I sell to the public. I provide the host setting with a list of delegates and I take care of all the admin work. I work in partnership with the setting to advertise the sessions. A minimum of 50% of the remaining tickets must sell to make the training viable. I discuss all of this with settings when they enquire. This is the most cost effective way to get high quality training.

VIRTUAL TRAINING

Many settings prefer to access training online to save time and cost and to stay safe. I offer most of my courses as online alternatives for a reduced fee. There is still a maximum number of attendees but settings may wish to 'buddy up' with local settings to share the cost.

LOOSE PARTS EXHIBITION

Loose parts involves using small 'loose' objects around you for children's play. The concept isn't new, but settings and schools are finding it more and more relevant as our sector moves towards more child-centred learning.

Through this training, delegates learn about the value of open-ended resources in bringing more purposeful play and the role that adults have in supporting this. They will also learn how to introduce these resources sensitively and appropriately, matching the culture of the setting to ensure Loose Parts play evolves naturally within the setting.

This training is a mixed approach of presentation and plenty of 'hands on' play with a wealth of resources - bring your camera!

Session length: 1.5 hours.

Set up time prior to event: 45 minutes

Pack away time: 30 minutes

Designed for: All staff working in Early Years (0-5) and KS1

Max number of attendees: 40

Cost - £250 per session.

PURPOSEFUL PROVISION

Do you have provision in your setting that falls a bit flat? Can you justify why you're delivering learning through provision? Do you have 'dead zones' in your classroom? This training is designed to support you in making every part of your environment work just as hard as you do!

Through this training, delegates are supported to understand how and why we do provision the way we do. Delegates will be supported to think about placing the child at the centre when designing provision. This hands on session is designed to challenge practitioners to develop the provision as a tool for learning and not just something which looks nice!

This training blends a mixture of approaches including a presentation, workshop activities and exploration of some resources.

Session length: 2 hours

Set up time prior to event: 30 minutes

Pack away time: 20 minutes

Designed for: Staff working with 2-5 year olds including NQTs, RQTs, New to Early Years staff & those wishing to deepen their understanding of provision.

Max number of attendees: 20

Cost - £275 per session.

FABULOUS PHASE 1 PHONICS

With the significant changes to Phonics in the UK right now it's more important than ever that practitioners understand the value of Phase 1 phonics.

Children need to have a solid understanding about recognising and making sounds, keeping a beat, understanding speech sounds as well as learning how to talk about the sounds they hear.

This active, hands on course is designed to support practitioners to recognise that phase 1 phonics can be woven into many activities already ongoing within their settings. It further supports them in understanding when to move children onto phase 2 and what to do when gaps exist.

This training blends a mixture of approaches including a presentation, workshop activities and exploration of some resources. Delegates will be required to move about and should therefore wear suitable clothing and footwear (non-strenuous)

Session length: 2 hours

Set up time prior to event: 20 minutes

Pack away time: 10 minutes

Designed for: Any staff who will be teaching phase 1 phonics.

Max number of attendees: 20

Cost - £275 per session.

This training is NOT available as virtual session.

CREATIVE & CURIOUS

Children are being pushed further and further down the route to 'academia.' Literacy and Mathematics are seen as important 'school readiness' skills and parents push these from an early age. Creativity is fast becoming squeezed out of our curricula or relegated to 'creative areas.' Creativity is an essential human skill but staff need to understand how to nurture the wonderful skills our children already possess.

If you're looking to bring creativity into the whole of your setting, including through independent play then this course is for you. Much of this course is devoted to the role of the adult.

This training blends a mixture of approaches including a presentation, workshop activities and exploration of some resources.

Session length: 2 hours

Set up time prior to event: 20 minutes

Pack away time: 10 minutes

Designed for: Staff working across Early Years and those with provision in KS1+

Max number of attendees: 40

Cost - £275 per session.

MATHS IN NURSERY - NEW FOR 2022

Maths doesn't start with numbers. There's so much more to it! My Maths in Nursery course delves into the foundations of early maths for 0-4 year olds. Through this hands-on course we'll develop your understanding of:

- Early Maths Skills
- Principles of Counting (and more)
- Number Sense
- Shape and Space
- Real Problem Solving
- Developing a Mathematically rich environment
- The role of the adult

This resource-rich course will support staff at all levels to plan for purposeful mathematical play which follows the needs and interests of the children.

Session length: 1.5 hours

Set up time prior to event: 45 minutes

Pack away time: 20 minutes

Designed for: Staff working in with children 0-4. Relevant for Reception staff if considering how to build on earlier content.

Max number of attendees: 30

Cost - £250 per session.

OUTDOOR ELEMENTS

- NEW FOR 2022
AVAILABLE FROM MARCH

Outdoors can be very challenging for practitioners. Many staff members struggle to know what to do outdoors, especially in the winter months. This has led to many settings focussing much more on indoor learning even when many children would learn so much from playing outdoors.

This course is designed to support practitioners to:

- Understand their 'why' of outdoor learning.
- Develop the basic elements required in all outdoor spaces.
- Develop meaningful experiences and opportunities for children.
- Understand the role of the adult in facilitating purposeful play.
- Understand how to develop provision which is appropriate and matches their culture.

This session is primarily based indoors with activities outdoors throughout the session (regardless of weather conditions). Staff should wear appropriate clothing.

Session length: 2 hours

Set up time prior to event: 45 minutes

Pack away time: 20 minutes

Designed for: Staff working across Early Years and those with provision in KS1+

Max number of attendees: 20

Cost - £275 per session.
